Gala Gift Gathering Parties

What is a Gift Gathering Party?

A Gift Gathering Party works much like a Birthday Party does. The party hosts invite friends and family into their home or other space and provide food and drink. Party invitations are printed by the school and include information regarding Gift Gathering Parties in general. Hosts complete these invitations with their event-specific information and mail them to their guests.

Gift Gathering Parties take many forms. Sometimes they are hosted by one family in their home or co-hosted by several families. Sometimes they are on Friday and Saturday nights. Other times they are Sunday brunches or early afternoon gatherings.

Guests are asked to bring a gift, which will be auctioned as part of the Gala. Suggested gifts to bring to a Gift Gathering Party include collectibles, artwork, crystal, jewelry, antiques, gift certificates, sports memorabilia and small appliances. If you are unsure of what to bring, guests should call their party host/hostess and ask for suggestions, which may include a cash gift that will be brought together with others to purchase one large gift from the party for the verbal auction. (Verbal Auction items are usually worth in excess of \$1,000 each and often include vacation opportunities, high-end jewelry and sports memorabilia.)
