# Student Accident Insurance 2021-2022

Good Afternoon Principals & Administrators,

As we continue to strive to provide a safe environment for all of our students, we recognize that accidents are not 100% preventable. In order to lessen the financial impact from a sudden and unexpected accident, we are once again offering student accident insurance through the Office of Risk Management. Similar to years past, our insurance program is a two-tiered approach: a voluntary paid basic plan providing up to \$25,000 coverage purchased by the students' families, and a catastrophic plan that has a \$5,000,000 coverage limit and a \$25,000 deductible, provided by the AOB for those schools participating in the AOB Property & Casualty insurance program.

The voluntary student accident plan can be purchased by any family with a student attending either an Archdiocesan school or an independent Catholic school within the Archdiocese, including pre-K students, and applies to accidents which occur on the school's premises during school activities. For school families who have very high deductibles on their health policies, or who may have no health coverage, this is a great opportunity to purchase protection for their children. The details of this plan can be reviewed in the attachments Student Accident Insurance Brochure 2021-2022 along with the coverage explanation brochure 2021-2022. There are various coverage options from which parents can select, but all are offered at very minimal costs. Most beneficial about

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this coverage is that it has no deductible. In order to simplify the purchasing process, parents have the option of submitting the application and payment directly to the company via regular mail, or they can go on line and complete the purchase at [www.BollingerSchools.com](http://www.BollingerSchools.com).
